## **Barr-Reeve Scholarship Foundation Honor Scholarships**

- Award:** \$300 BRSF honor scholarships are renewable each year provided student re-applies each year and maintains a minimum 2.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale. Award amounts were \$800 for sophomores, juniors, seniors, and 5<sup>th</sup> year students.
- School:** Any
- Major:** Any
- Criteria:** Must be a graduating senior of Barr-Reeve High School with a 2.0/4.0 after seven semesters, an acceptable school attendance record, and must be planning to attend an accredited college, university or vocational program. A copy of the student's letter of acceptance or statement of fees must be provided before funds will be distributed to student. Applications are available from Mr. Kavanaugh, President of the BRSF.

## **The Frank and Margaret Arvin Family Educational Assistance Trust and the Dallas K. Conolty Scholarship**
